Permit Application for Blasting/Explosives

Procedure:

- Approximate 60 day turn-around from date of submittal
- Applicant shall provide a copy of this application to the appropriate city/county where the blasting will take place
- Applicant shall post a copy of the permit at the blasting site
- 1 Permit per site. This application is for blasting ONLY. Storage of explosives requires a separate application through this office

Required Documentation:

All blasting, use and storage of explosives shall conform to the requirements of NFPA 495 & IFC 2012 Chapter 56 Explosives & Fireworks

Contractor's License, Certification from the State of Arizona and a license to use explosives from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms

Provide proof of insurance of 1 million dollars (\$1,000,000) per permit. The insurance shall list Sedona Fire District as additional insured

Map showing levels of impact and monitoring locations

Work area relative to structures and underground and/or overhead utilities

Storage location of explosives to be used before, during and after each blast – Storage of explosives within Sedona Fire District requires a separate permit through this office

Description of maximum quantities of explosives for each day of operation

Type and size of explosive products to be used

Method of ignition of the explosives

Hours of Operation

Loud warning signals prior to each blast

Manner of locating and neutralizing or detonating any misfires

Manner of clearing site after blast

Manner by which utility, emergency services, and government bodies are to be notified in the event of an emergency

Fees:

Plan Review = \$175.00/hour

Blasting Permit = \$100.00

Onsite Inspector = \$85.00/hour – 3 hour minimum additional time is billable

Explosive Storage = \$1000.00 + \$100.00/Day
