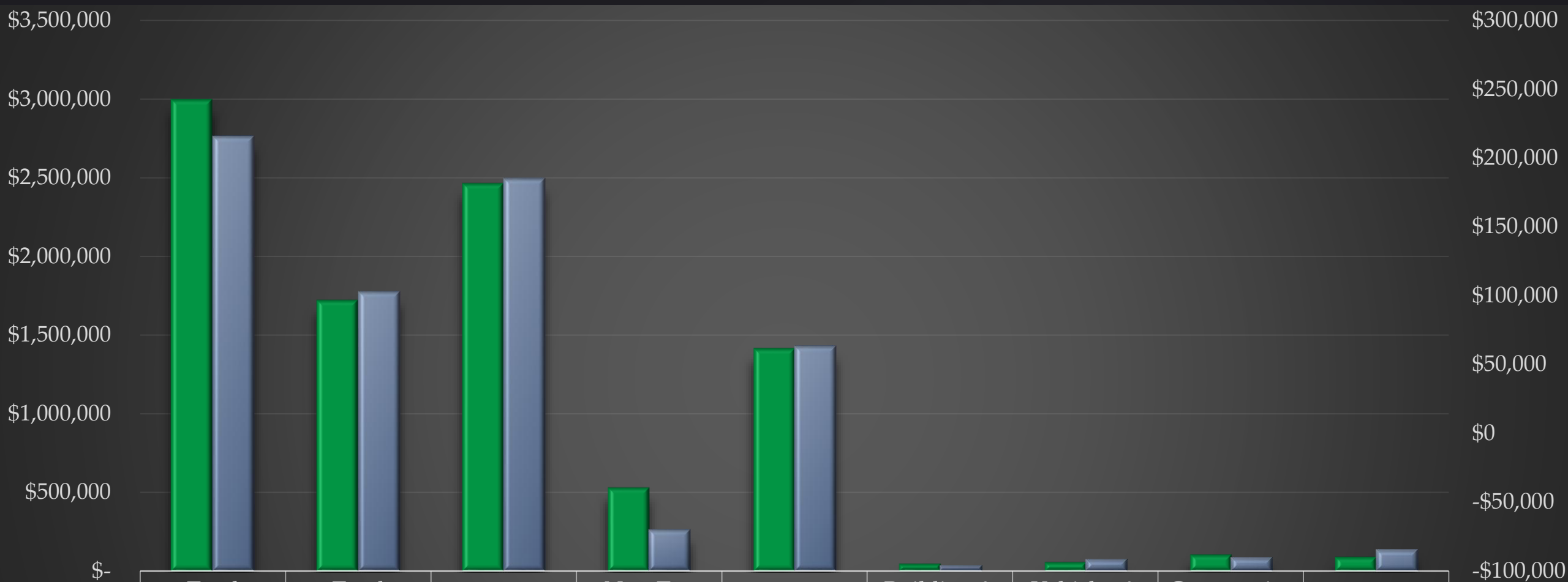

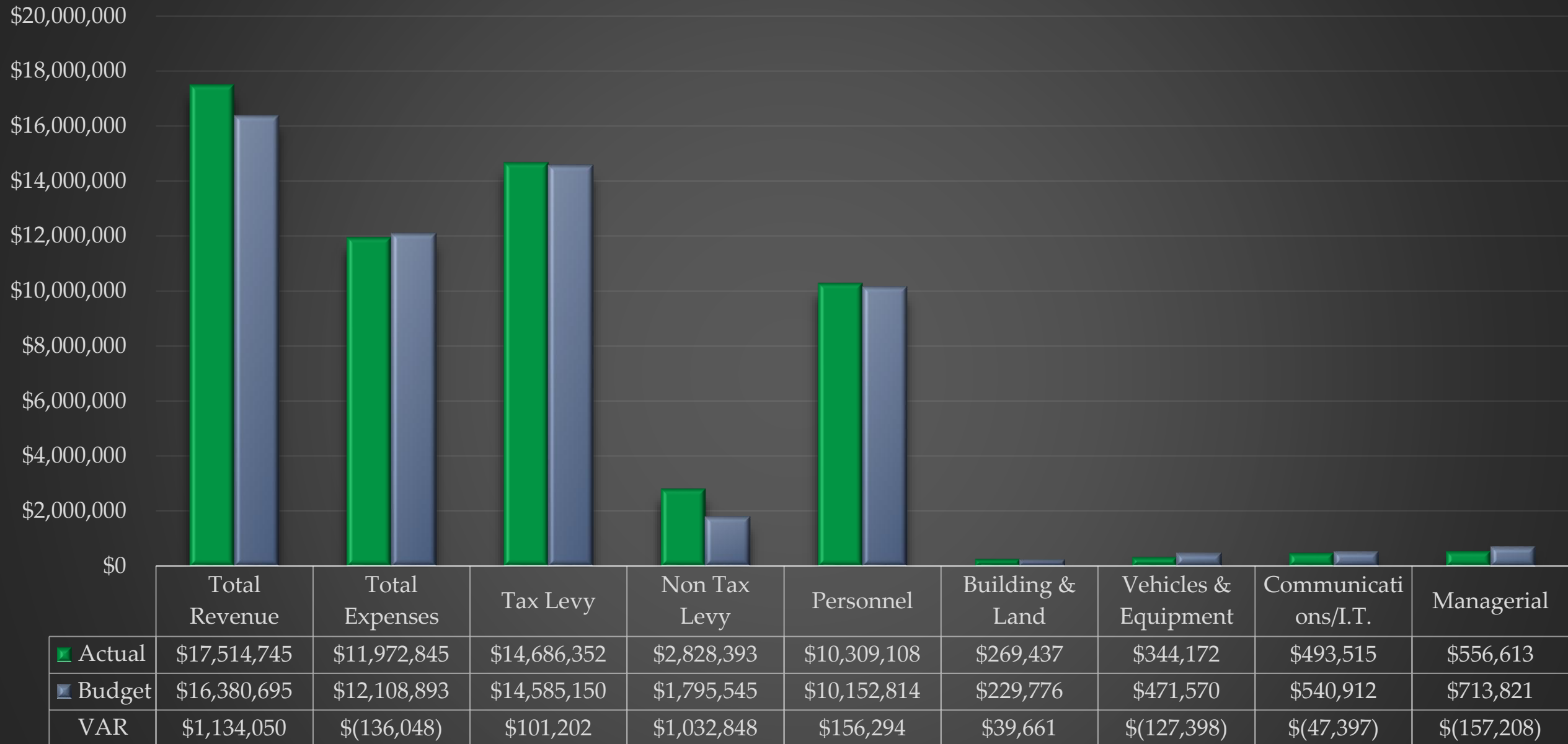

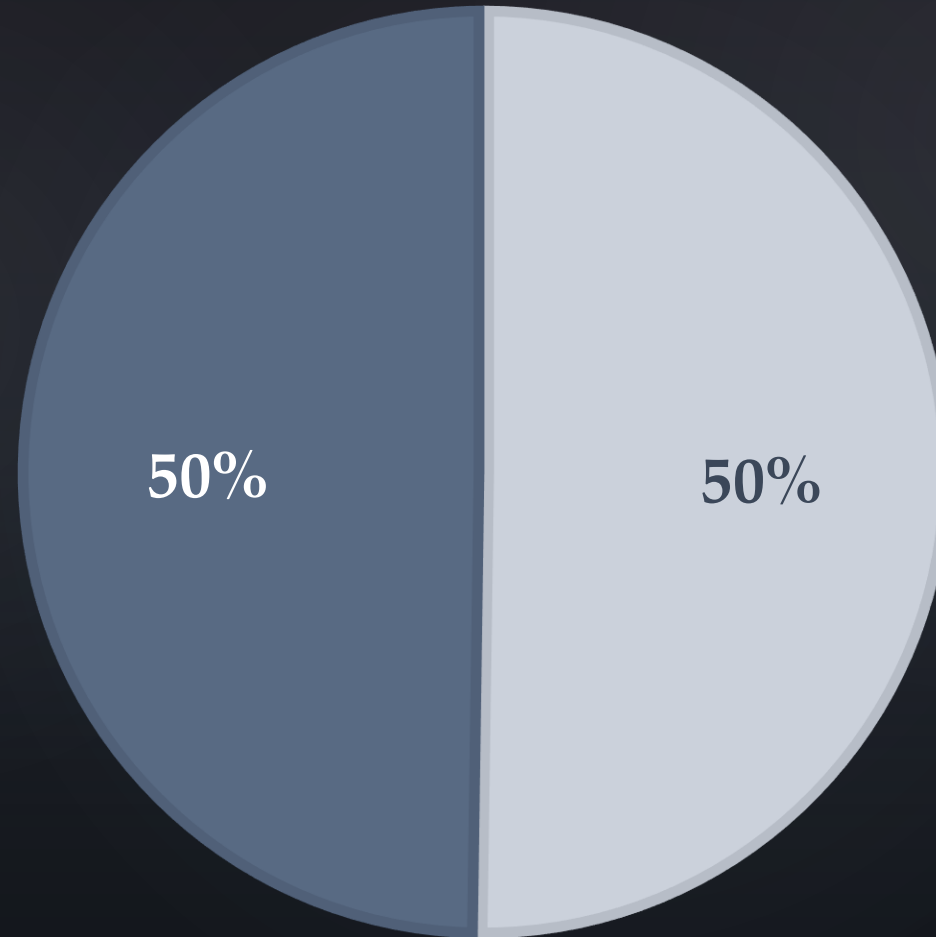
# Fiscal Year to Date Budget to Actual

■ Actual YTD

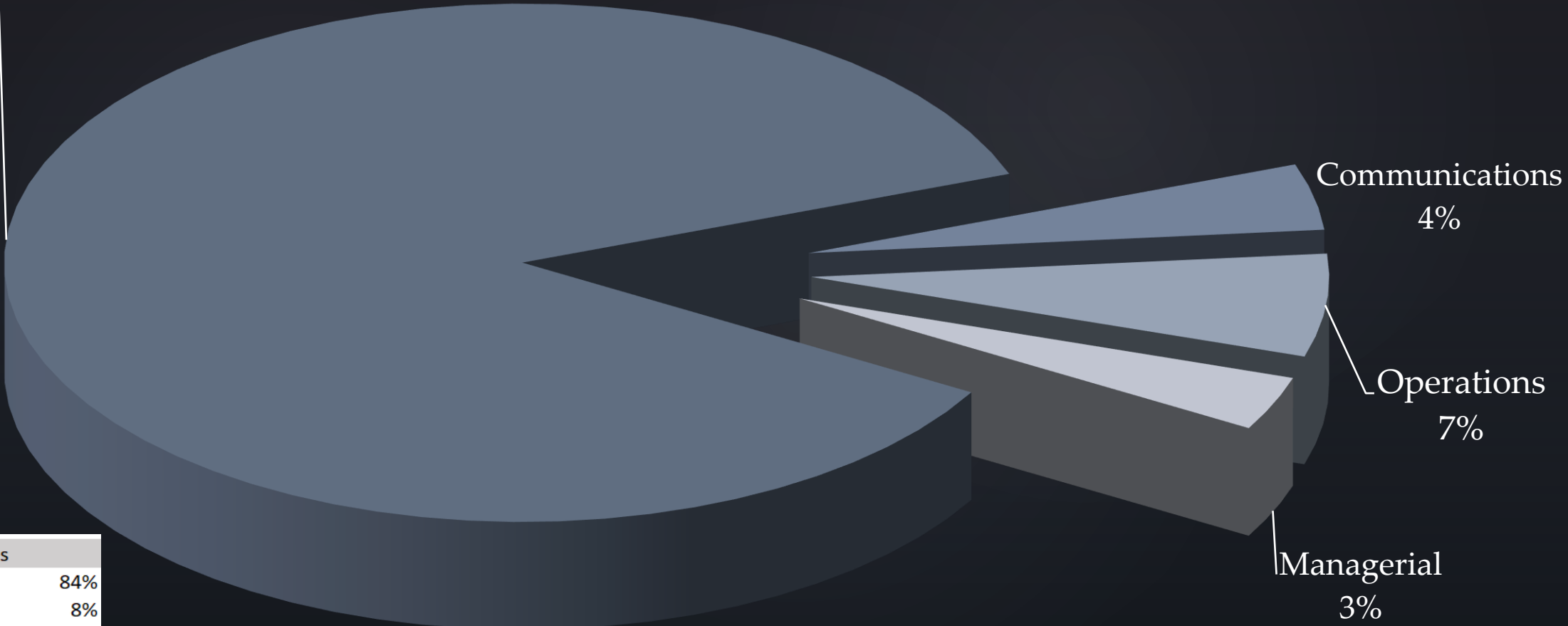

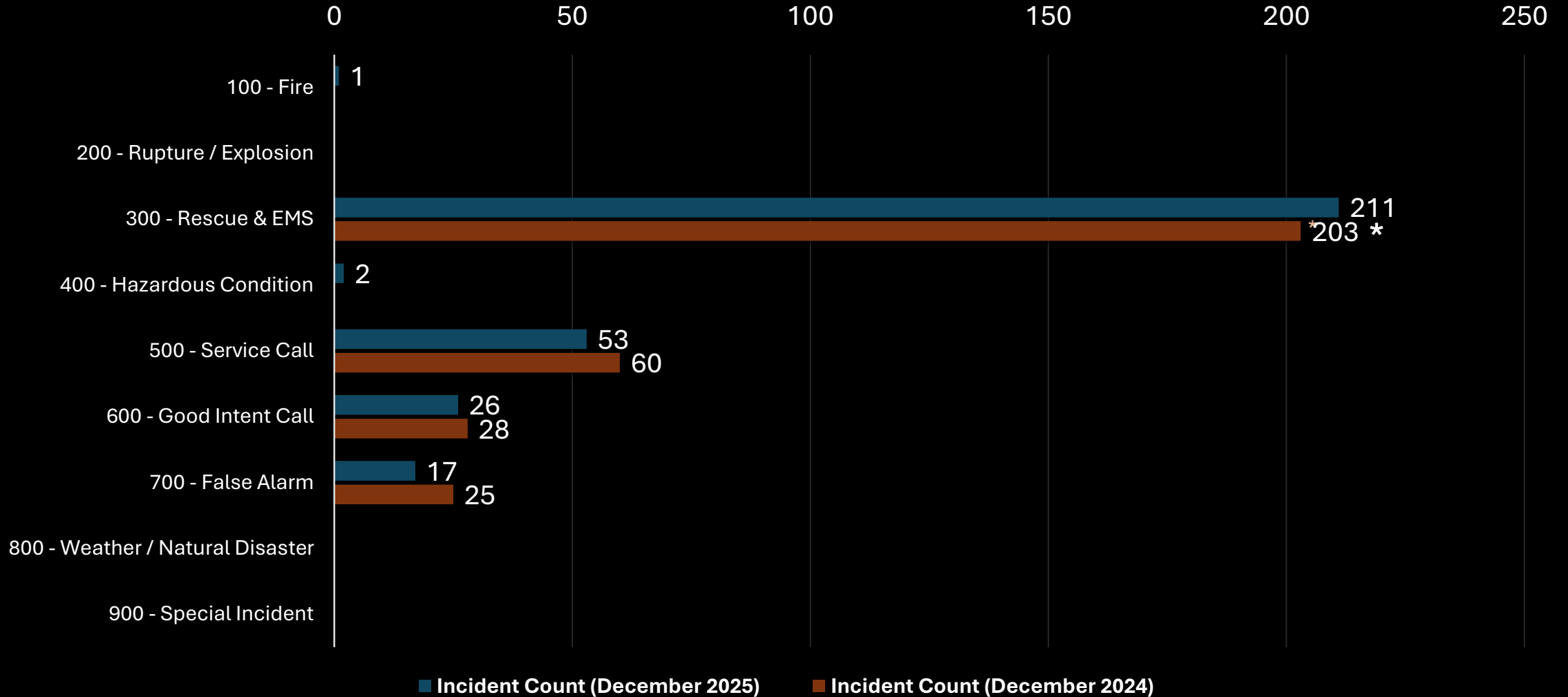

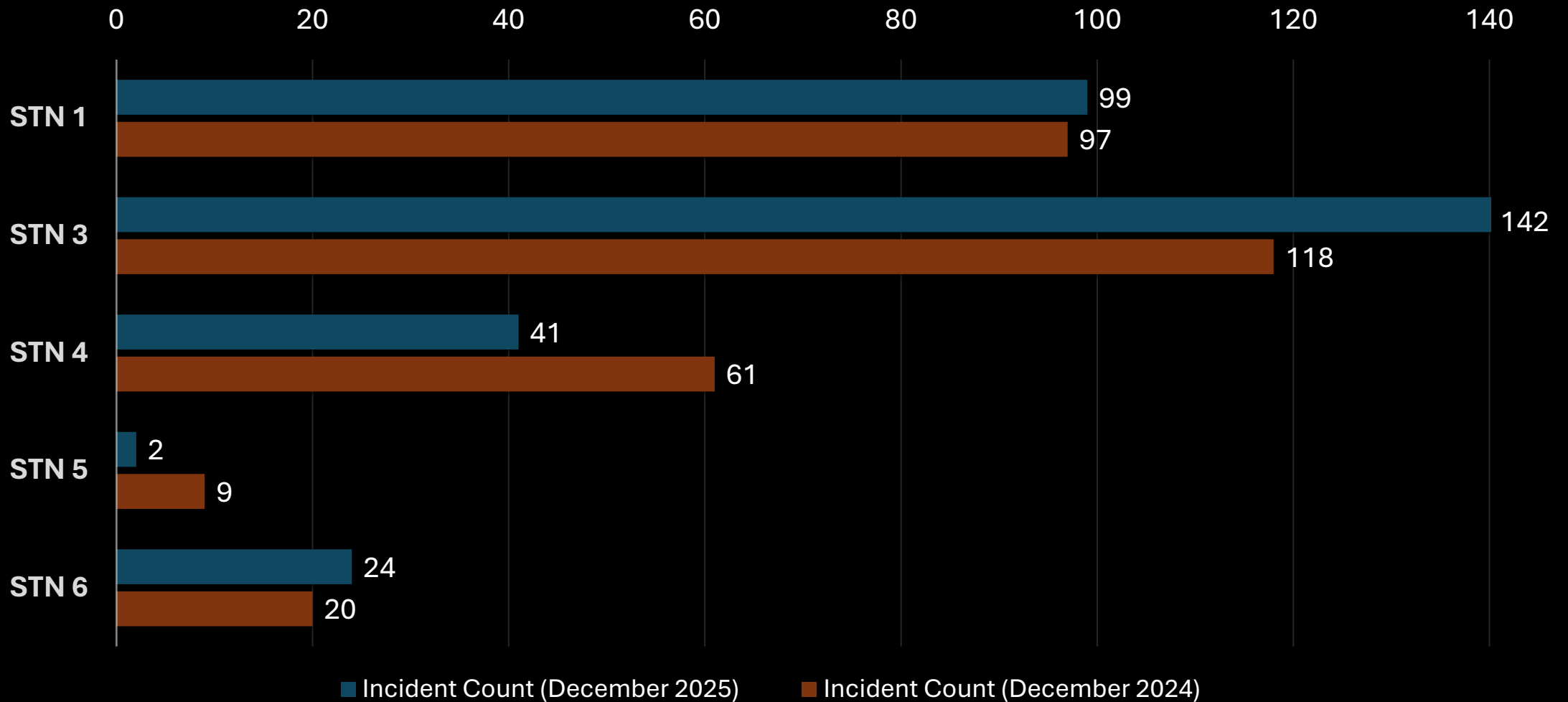

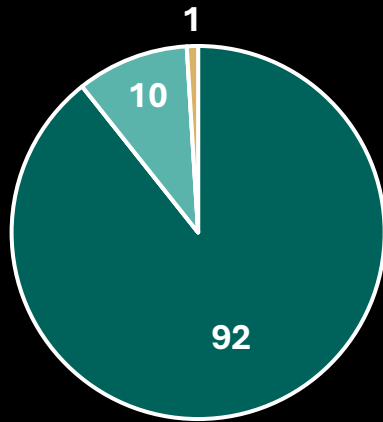

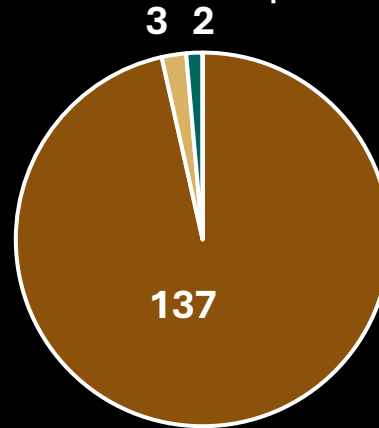

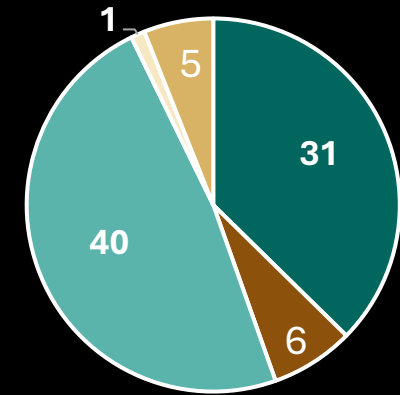
### Station 1 Responses



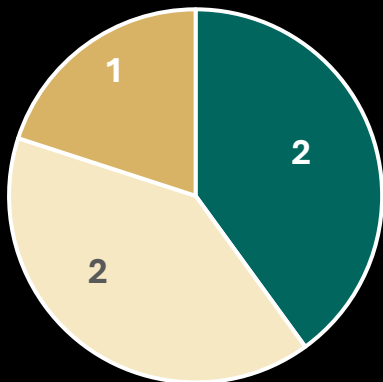

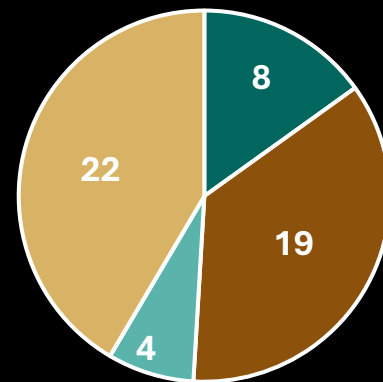

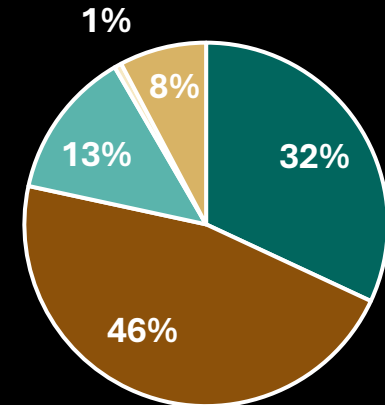
